TEMECULA VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT And TEMECULA VALLEY EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION CTA/NEA Joint Presentation of Initial Proposals for Reopener Contract Negotiations for the 2025-2026 School Year

April 15, 2025

As required by the Educational Employment Relations Act (EERA), specifically California Government Code Section 3547, the Temecula Valley Unified School District (District) and Temecula Valley Educators Association (Association) present their initial proposals for reopener contract negotiations for the 2025-2026 school year. In accordance with Article 29 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), the parties have agreed to reopeners on Article 7: Compensation and Benefits. In addition, the District and the Association each have the ability to reopen two (2) articles for negotiations.

The District and Association have agreed to sunshine their proposals jointly, and to present the proposals as concepts and interests rather than as end results.

The presentation of each party's initial proposals in this side-by-side format is designed to assist the public in reviewing and assessing both parties' initial proposals and interests, so that the public will be able to comment on the initial proposals at the public hearing on this matter.
